Role

Key responsibilities include:

- Developing and delivering Audit and Financial Reporting training materials for courses from introductory level to CPD Updates. Courses run UK-wide and include classroom-based workshops, CPD lectures and webinars.
- Researching emerging technical areas and writing training materials for use by the wider Insight Training team.
- Performing audit file reviews (cold and hot) which are carried out remotely and onsite.
- Answering ad hoc technical queries on auditing and financial reporting (UK GAAP and IFRS).

The role is broad in scope, and you will be fully supported. There are plenty of opportunities to grow and develop within the business in various areas, depending on your skill set and areas of interest. These might include developing a technical specialism or broader facilitation and coaching skills.

The successful applicant will be a confident, enthusiastic self-motivated individual with the experience and desire to play an important role in a small and growing business. You will:
